

OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE IN UZBEKISTAN

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ABSTRACT

In the Republic of Uzbekistan, people aged 14 to 30 are considered youth. As long as we can inculcate the main factors of increasing the activity of young people in the socio-economic and political-spiritual spheres into the minds of our scientific and creative young intellectuals, we will create the strongest spiritual and educational pillar of the foundation of the Third Renaissance.

On the initiative of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev, the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated August 25, 2017 "On Establishing the Day of the Youth of the Republic of Uzbekistan" was adopted, and June 30 was designated as "Youth Day" in our country.

Strengthening the position of young people in socio-economic and political-spiritual spheres is a very urgent issue in the construction of New Uzbekistan. We are implementing the Action Strategy step by step. In improving the state policy for the development of the social sphere, we are first of all carrying out democratic reforms while educating them to be physically healthy, mentally fresh, have a broad outlook on the world, adapt to the times, think in harmony, and be loyal to the Motherland. Working with young people, supporting their creative and intellectual potential, involving them in the development of culture, sports, and tourism, introducing our national economy to the world market based on foreign experience in a modern way, exporting competitive products, developing their entrepreneurship in various fields, establishing cooperation with compatriots. Issues such as installation are carried out in a certain institutional form.

Including:

- In 2018, in accordance with the Decree of the President of Uzbekistan, the State program "Youth is our future" was approved. Through this document, assistance and support in the implementation of entrepreneurship, StartUPs, ideas and projects has been raised to a new level;

- In 2020, another important step was taken in the direction of youth, and according to the decision of the President, a state organization that implements youth policy in the country - Youth Affairs Agency was established. In order to motivate young people at a high level, the "Mardoglan" state award and the "Builder of the Future" medal were established;

- Another important step is that 2021 was declared the year of "Supporting youth and strengthening the health of the population" and the State Program for the development of this sector was adopted. A 5-year strategy for the development of youth policy was developed.

Also, the number of benefits in the "Youth Register" will be increased to 25, 1.2 million soums will be allocated to young people for learning IT and a foreign language, 12 million soums will be given to participants of international Olympiads for their expenses, piano, status and the state pays for the contract of those who study charity. According to the decision of the government, one-time financial assistance in the amount of 1,200,000 soums will be given to young people in the "Youth register" and those who have a difficult financial situation. An unsecured loan for new young families to build a house, rent compensation, financial support

for treatment and language learning - a number of subsidies for young people have been introduced.

The government's youth policy program for 2022-2023 envisages social support, consultations, trainings, competitions, marathons, etc. It is planned to work with unorganized youth based on the principle of "free time of the youth is the working time of the leader".

Alisher Sadullayev, the head of the Youth Affairs Agency, announced the launch of the yosh sailovchi.uz electronic platform for young people. Through the platform, it will be possible to identify a polling station and register to participate in the election as a volunteer or trainer. Youth industrial and entrepreneurship zones will be established in all regions of Uzbekistan. 77 such zones will be opened by September.

Shavkat Mirziyoyev noted that every 15 days, 1 month, the activity of the hokims will be evaluated based on the initiative they have taken with regard to youth, and it will be decided whether they will stay in the job or not. "For 27 years, we did not educate young people, we did not listen to their pain. "Young people are 20 times ahead of us," said the head of state.

The Legislative Chamber of the Oliy Majlis also carried out a number of tasks regarding the implementation of the tasks given at the video selector meeting, which was held under the chairmanship of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on July 4 of this year, dedicated to the issues of effective organization of the implementation of the State program "Youth - our future". In particular, in order to effectively organize the implementation of the State program on the ground, members of the Legislative Chamber's Commission on Youth Affairs and deputies were attached to each region of the country, and they worked as part of the Republican working groups.

Deputies of the Legislative Chamber assigned to the regions carried out promotion and propaganda activities to convey the essence of the State Program to the youth, practical assistance was provided to regional and local working groups in the work to ensure the implementation of the tasks specified in the Decree. For example, on July 12 of this year in Navoi region, a press conference dedicated to the content of this historical document was held, and on July 17, at the initiative of the Legislative Chamber's Commission on Youth Issues, political parties and "Youth Wings" organized the implementation of the State Program "Youth is our future". A seminar was organized on the topic "the place and role of".

Practical dialogues and seminars were held with the participation of representatives of all official offices and organizations during the meetings in Khorezm region hokimiyati, as well as in Moynaq, Amudarya and Ellikkala districts of the Republic of Karakalpakstan.
